### In Spring 2 Year 6 will be learning . . .

**English:**  
We will be focusing on several different forms of high quality media: short stories, short videos, and drama..

Our text genres are as follows: Narrative writing, Non-chronological report, and persuasion.

**Philosophy:**  
We will be asking and answering questions related to the role of governments, and what to do if you believe that something is unjust.

#### Humanities (History)

A study of democracy. With specific reference to the Peterloo Massacre, and the suffragette movement. We will be comparing the politics and role of government in Britain to another country. We will be discussing the different levels of government and how they may impact our lives as citizens.

#### PSHE

We will continue to work on team-building, healthy relationships, and speak about the new responsibilities associated with transitioning to high school.

#### PE

During this term the children will be focused on ball and invasion games. We will also be participating in dance units

We will complete our assessments on electricity and move onto light.

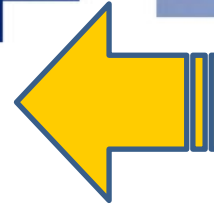
