English

We will start the term furthering our learning on the genre 'instructions'. We will then shift our focus to 'explanations' and learn how these two text types are different. We also be writing poetry based on 'I am the seed that grew the tree'. Most if our English units will be based on texts inspired by plants.

Philosophy:

English

In Philosophy, we will continue to embed our talk moves. We will focus on building on others' ideas by adding information to explain why we agree.

In Summer 2 Year 1 will be learning . . .

Geography

In Geography, we are looking at the UK. We will learn about the countries of the UK. We will learn where they are, what they look like on a map. We will then look at each country in more detail. We will learn about their different cultures and traditions. We will learn about how they are similar and how they are different.

Computing

In Computing, we will take the skills we have learnt in barefoot. coding and apply them to a new language. We will begin our multimedia unit by learning how to use a word processor.

During this term the children will be focusing on athletics. They will be working on a range of athletics skills, building to sports day!

History

PSHF:

Our PSHE units will be based around national curriculum standards, and be taught weekly. Some examples of topics are: healthy friendships, healthy eating, managing emotions.

RF:

In RE, we will be learning about sacred places. We will be focusing on Islam and Christianity. We will learn about why those places are sacred, and what makes them sacred. We will compare similarities and differences.

Maths

This half term we are starting by consolidating our knowledge of different methods of addition and subtraction. We will be consolidating our learning on multiplication and division. Focusing on different methods. We will finish the term by introducing the children to statistics and ways to represent data.

Science

This half term we will be continuing our learning about plants. We will be focusing on the conditions plants need for growth. We will continue our work on seasons and explore Summer in more details. We will link our science unit to our English writing outcomes.
